Symmetric Relay Pass

Opening bids:

Notes: When the partner has passed and opponents open, all bids assume partner has the 0-7 hand. That gives a lot of room for pre-emptive bids as they are forcing if the opening hand has 17+ but otherwise just for passing. That gives the bids after opponents opening a range somewhere 2-16p depending on vulnerability and hand type.

After partner has passed, the opening bids are such as below:

| \diamondsuit = 8.16p, either Bal 8-14 or 4M with 4+m OR 5+5+ms
| \heartsuit / \spadesuit = 8.16p, 5+M
| NT = 15.17p, Bal (may be semibal or 4441)
| 2 \clubsuit / \diamondsuit = 8.16p, 5+m, unbalanced, denies 4card major
| 2 \heartsuit = 8.16p, 5+5+ Ms
| 2 \spadesuit = 0.7p, 5+♠
```

If the pass opener has a strong hand, he bids the relay bid as if the responder opened the bidding.

After partner has opened I , responder bids as below:

| \heartsuit / \spadesuit = 8.11, 5+M
| NT = 8.11, somewhat balanced
| 2♣/\diamondsuit = 8.11, 5+m. 2\diamondsuit denies 4M, 2♣ may have 4♠
| 2♥ = 8.11, 4♥, 5+m
| 2♠ = 8.11, 4♠, 5+\diamondsuit
| 2NT = 8.11, 5+5+Ms
```

After the bidding $1 - 1 \diamondsuit$, opener re-opens using the same bids as the responder did, although all bids show 12-16 except INT that shows 15-17. If responder has 12+, he uses the same relay bid as the opening bid.

After opening I♦:

After opening $I\heartsuit/\Phi$:

After opening $2\clubsuit$, $2\diamondsuit$ is GF relay and other bids invitational for game,

After opening 2♦:

2\heartsuit = GF \text{ relay}
2NT = 5+\heartsuit, Forcing I round.
```

After opening 2%, major is to play and 2NT GF relay.
