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NOTE 1

1NT-respond over 1st FG

1NT as respond over 1st is forcing to game with any distribution.

Responding 1M over 1st doesn't deny FG values but we almost (cannot remember any case we haven't) use 1NT when we will reach at least gamelevel.

Over responses 2 \clubsuit upto 3 \clubsuit relay asks for more specific DIST and from 3 \diamond the 4 cheapest bids except 3NT and 4 \diamond sets trump and asks for strength and aces. 3NT is for play and 4 \diamond is an endsignalbid.

2 \clubsuit -respond over 1M FG

2 \clubsuit as respond over 1M is forcing to game with any distribution.

Responding 1 \spadesuit over 1 \heartsuit doesn't deny FG values but we almost (cannot remember any case we haven't) use 2 \clubsuit when we intend to reach at least gamelevel.

If openingbid was 1 \heartsuit the responses 3 \heartsuit and 3 \spadesuit is impossible why 3 \heartsuit is 4414 and 3 \spadesuit is 6421 and so on.

Over responses 2 \diamond upto 3 \clubsuit relay asks for more specific DIST and from 3 \diamond the 4 cheapest bids except 3NT and 4 \diamond sets trump and asks for strength and aces. 3NT is for play and 4 \diamond is an endsignalbid.

If opponents Double or bid

- RD is suggest
- Dbl is PEN
- PASS over Dbl shows min and RH:s RD is new question SYSON
- Bid over Dbl shows maximum and SYSON

If opponents Double higher bid

NOTE 2

2nd - Opening

Shows 3-10 Hcp and at least 44 i majors. It's unusual w/ 64 DIST but w/ bad 6c suit it is possible. Opening in 2nd position VUL we use to have a decent opening either w/ 55 DIST or maximum HCP.

Responses

Competitive bidding

If OPPT Dbl, pass is NEU and Rdbl strong w/ some values in ♦. After pass OH Rdbl w/ equal length and otherwise bid his 5c suit.

IF OPPT bid NT or a suit, Dbl is PEN

NOTE 3

TRF overcalls vs 1\$ / " that don't promise 3+card suit.

This defence, called "Lützen", can (and we almost do) be used vs minor openings that not promise 3c.

It has also been used vs NAT minor openings, unfourtunally with some success. Although this methods now a days is prohibited in most tournaments we only use it as described above.

Subsequent auction

After transferovercalls

Over the signoff 1 in shown

Pass w/ 5+c and upto 15 Hcp

1M doesn't promise more than 44 and does not promise any extra strength.

1NT shows 15 - 17. Higher bids are NAT and strong F1.

After 1NT(15 - 17) 2♣ = asking M, 2♦ = any signoff , 2♥ - 3♠ NAT INV.

If OPPT:s bid Dbl: 1 trick in shown suit is still WK but promis 3c SUPP.

After the 1[♠] overcall

1NT	16 - 19	As opening 1NT
2♣	20 +	Only forcing bid.
2X	13 - 19	NAT 5c+

If OPPT:s Dbl 1♠ Rdbl = "I have an own 1♠-overcall"

1♠ bidder is supposed to save himself by Rdbl as SOS or 2X NAT.

1NT denies MIN. Further Rdbls are SOS.

NOTE 4

Vinje signals in trump

If possible, playing low-high in trump shows parity of the hand. 3 suits with an even number of cards and playing high-low show 3 suits with an odd number of cards.

Obvious shift

Is ON when its obvious not to continue in that suit

Dummy has:

- Singel/void , or its obvious that declarer has
- A suit w/AKQ
- A suit w/ QJx(x) and you lead K
- A suit w/ Kxx(x) and you lead A and declarer is probably short
- You lead the A/K and dummy has 2 cards

Low = Intolerance for the obvious shift

High = Tolerance for the obvious shift (Jxx or weaker A or K , Qxx or better A,K or Q)

The obvious shift suit is in priority dummies:

1. Bad three card (1/3)
2. Shortest suit (not singel/void)
3. W/ equal length the weakest
4. W / equal strength the lowest

Obvious shift suit is never, in priority:

- The leading suit
- Triumph
- A suit w AKQ or 4 of 5 honors
- Dummies single/void suit
- A suit bid by declarer

Obvious shift is always partners suit or your own suit,
