



DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; 1/2 Level; Reopening)
Light to Normal strength on 1-level. Normal strength on 2-level.
(1m) - 1♠ - (p/D/1NT) - ?
2♣ = ART 11+, 2♦ = 5+♥, 2♥ = unbid m
Similar if we overcall 1♥ but then 2♦ = unbid m
If opening was 1♥ then 2♦ = ♦ while 2♥ = ♣
Reopening may be light.
1N OVERCALL (2 <sup>nd</sup> /4 <sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18 Responds as opening 1NT
Reop' = 11-14
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
(1m/♥)-2M = wk 6+ (1m)-2NT = 55, om +♥
(1♣)-2/3♦ = 4♥ w/ (5)6+♦ (1♦)-3♣ = 55, ♠+♣
(1M)-3♣ = oM+♦
5-5 bids are wk or strong, 7-11 or 16+ (exc. 1♦-3♣)
DIRECT AND JUMP CUE-BIDS (Style; Responses; Reopen)
(1m)-2m = ♠+♥ (1M)-2M = oM+♣
(1♣)-3♣ = ♠+♦ (1♦/M)-3♦/M = ask for stopper
At least 5-5, wk or strong, 7-11 or 16+
VS. NT (Vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening; Passed Hand)
D = strength
2♣ = stayman, doesn't promise both M
2♦ = wk 5+M (multi)
2M = constructive 5+M
VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
D = T/O
Cue = 2-suiter
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS
Natural

Many transfers in competitive bidding

Lo-Hi = no better suit than lead (but not promising the lead was OK)

TAKEOUT DOUBLES (Style; Responses; Reopening)			
Double is for T/O unless agreed otherwise			
Normal strength. Lighter in Reop' pos.			
After (1♠) - D - (p) - 1NT = weak OR 8-10 bal (NF)			
SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL AND COMPETITIVE DOUBLES/REDOUBLES			
If we have bid 2M in comp. bidding and opp bids, D = "3M but you may pass"

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
Strong club, 17+
"Catch-all"-Diamond, 1♦ = 11-16, 0+
Specialized 2x
1NT Openings: 14-16
2-over-1 Responses: GF unless rebid
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENCE
1♣ = 17+, any dist except 21-22NT
1♦ = 11-16, 0+♦ (all hands not opened elsewhere, incl. long ♣)
2♣ = (0)3-9 4♥ & 5+m
2♦ = (0)3-9 4♠ & 5+m
2M = 10-13, 4M & 5+m
3x = 10-13 decent 7+suit
3NT = pre in one minor (1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> seat)
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
1♣ - (D/1x) - pass = wk or Pen.pass
IMPORTANT NOTES THAT DON'T FIT ELSEWHERE
We have a lot of transfers in comp. bidding.
